

## **2010 BC Wildlife Federation ARTIST OF THE YEAR Joyce Trygg**

Joyce Trigg was chosen as the BC Wildlife Federation 2010 Artist of the Year Award and will be honored at the 54<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting & Convention in April, 2010.



Born in a small town on Nova Scotia's Eastern Shore, Joyce Trygg now resides on a farm in historic Fort Langley with her husband and assortment of dogs, cats and horses. She began drawing as a child, majored in Art at school and attended Art classes at Douglas College, excelling at drawing, painting, sculpture and Art History.

In 1999 Joyce joined the Federation of Canadian Artists and Fraser Valley Chapter of the F.C.A. She began entering juried shows and attended workshops with many prominent Canadian and American artists; wildlife workshops at Toni and Paco Young's

Beartooth School of Art in Montana with Terry Isaac where Paco Young and Daniel Smith were guest lecturers, Wildstreak Art in Penticton with Terry Isaac, John Banovich, Daniel Smith and John Seerey-Lester. In 2007 Joyce was accepted as an associate member of Women Artists of the West. Joyce's painting can be viewed at the Birthplace of BC Gallery in Fort Langley, B.C.

BC Wildlife Federation's "Artist of the Year" program began in 1992 with the goal of raising the profile of artists whose work exemplifies the beauty of the fish, wildlife and habitat of British Columbia. The sale of limited edition Artist of the Year prints contributes to BCWF conservation projects throughout the province.

BCWF, representing over 35,000 members, is the province's oldest and largest voluntary conservation organization representing conservation-minded anglers and hunters whose aim is to protect, enhance and promote the wise use of the environment for the benefit of present and future generations.
