September, 2008	2010 Artist of the Year Program Launch
February 28, 2009	Deadline for submissions' acceptance
March 15, 2009	Selection of three (3) finalists. Finalists will be asked to submit original art.
April 25, 2009	Presentation of 2009 Artist of the Year, Myles Mathis, at the BC Wildlife Federation's Award Banquet.
April 25, 2009	Announcement of 2010 Artist of the Year at the BC Wildlife Federation's Award Banquet..
October, 2009	2010 Artist of the Year artwork is released.

Property Insurance

- ◆ All participants are advised to obtain adequate property insurance for their respective entries and originals for shipping and handling.
- ◆ Original artwork is ****NOT**** to be sent unless specifically requested by the BC Wildlife Federation.
- ◆ The artist or his/her agent are and must be responsible for assuming adequate insurance coverage for artwork for shipping.
- ◆ The BC Wildlife Federation, the **Art Selection Jury**, or anyone working on its behalf is not and will not be responsible for damages, to entry/ entries/ original/ originals, that occur(s) in the mail, by courier, fire, theft or any other act of God.

Details for Successful Artist of the Year

- ◆ The artist agrees to grant **all** reproduction rights for the winning entry to the BC Wildlife Federation.
- ◆ All artworks must be numbered and signed by the artist.
- ◆ All artworks will be marketed through the BC Wildlife Federation.
- ◆ The artist will donate a pencil sketch for use by the BC Wildlife Federation on fundraising programs and other select programs to be used in 2010.
- ◆ The selected artist is not required to donate the original; however the artist must sign a written contract giving the BC Wildlife Federation all copyrights of the limited edition reproduction.
