Wetland Education and Conservation - Horseshoe Bay to Whistler

BCWF's Wetlands Education Program is excited to announce the *Sea to Sky Series*, a series of eight Wetlandkeepers Workshops in the Sea to Sky Corridor from 2009 – 2011! The Sea to Sky Corridor, extending from West Vancouver to Pemberton, is a highly diverse ecosystem that has been impacted by development. Through hands-on fieldwork and training at different sites, wetlands will be restored rehabilitated and conserved. Upon completion of a two and a half day *Sea to Sky Series* workshop, participants will contribute to lasting legacies by enhancing a wetland and will gain knowledge to implement community-based stewardship projects in their own backyards!

Sea to Sky Workshops during the summer of 2009:

Wetlandkeepers: Larson Creek Wetland, West Vancouver

Learn how to identify plants, amphibians and other wetland species during this weekend workshop in Eagle Ridge Bluffs. Participants will compile an inventory of species and will also learn how to install a Photo Point Monitoring system to easily capture changes in wetlands over the long-term. *May 29th-31st, 2009.*

Wetlandkeepers: Lost Lake Wetland, Whistler

Get involved in remediation work on Lost Lake Wetland, which was the dumping site of a saw mill in the 1940's. Over two weekends, participants will aid in water quality sampling, wetland clean-up and replanting to increase habitat for the endangered Western Toad. *August and September, 2009.*
